Six Senses prepares to open its latest hideaway on a distant Vietnamese island.



LOCATED IN THE HEART OF A 16-island archipelago off the south coast of Vietnam, Six Senses Con Dao instills Six Senses' philosophy of selecting remote but accessible areas of outstanding natural beauty. Accessible by daily flights from Ho Chi Minh City, the property opens in December and features contemporary architecture, with locally-sourced and sustainably produced materials chosen to fit seamlessly into the terrain.

Villas include both single and duplex configurations, and each boast their own infinity pool, indoor and outdoor bathrooms, and views out across the South China Sea. In addition, a series of three and four-bedroom residences will be for sale.

Almost 80 percent of Con Dao Island remains national park, including a 150sqkm marine reserve boasting some of Vietnam's best coral reefs. Divers may encounter hawks-bill turtles and dugongs, while black haired goats, wild pigs and macaque monkeys can be spied during guided tours through the island's dense tropical jungle.
